

## **OUTDOOR, IN-PERSON GATHERING GUIDELINES**

As we gather outdoors this summer, we commit to the in-person Gathering guidelines as an act of care for one another and our broader community, respecting that each of us will have varying levels of comfort as we do so. Whether joining Gatherings with others from your household or not, or with those in your “committed circle” (the people who you’ve been in regular contact with = “unit”), please be prepared to engage by bringing appropriate supplies, while adhering to the following:

- Please keep a *minimum* of eight feet between you and those around you. (As we are able, we’ll mark off areas for folks to populate with chalk paint, etc.)
  - You may do this by walking as a “unit” (if we are on the move together),
  - placing your chair/blanket/mat/island at a distance and remaining on it,
  - or pulling up in your vehicle and remaining in your trunk.
- Please bring a print off of the liturgy (or use your phone) and communion elements. These items will not be provided. Any additional resources for Gatherings will be communicated in advance.
- In the event that weather prohibits outdoor gatherings, we’ll communicate by 8am and move to Zoom at 10am.
- Please stay home and well if you have a cough or fever. Do let us ([contact@indytrinity.org](mailto:contact@indytrinity.org)) know if you are sick and at home.
- About 30% of our church family is in an “at risk” category. For the safety of everyone, and in order to love one another well, we ask that if you can’t adhere to these guidelines that you kindly refrain from attending.
